

VCEA/VCAA Webinar: Understanding the Victorian Curriculum F-10 EAL Version 2.0

Professional Learning Opportunity-Term 3

The Victorian Catholic Education Authority (VCEA) invites Catholic schools to participate in an online professional learning webinar focussed on the Victorian Curriculum F-10 EAL Version 2.0, scheduled for implementation in Catholic schools in 2027.

The session will be presented by Kellie Heintz, EAL Curriculum Manager at the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA). Kellie will share key insights into the revised curriculum and its implications for supporting students who are learning English as an Additional Language (EAL).

This webinar is designed for F-10 mainstream classroom teachers, including those working with students in receipt of funding through VCEA's New Arrivals Program and the Refugee Strategy Support Program.

The session will provide:

- an overview of the structure of the Victorian Curriculum F-10 EAL Version 2.0
- familiarisation with the resources available to support schools in preparing for and implementing the revised curriculum
- support teachers to plan as they plan next steps in the implementation of the revised curriculum.
